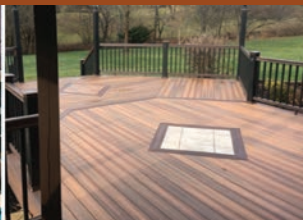

What's in a name?

By 1725, the use of the name Skippack started to appear. There are a couple of theories as to where this name came from and the most plausible seems to be that there were two villages in Bavaria, Germany named "Schippach" or a small stream in Holland named "Schipbeek." The colonist perhaps brought the name with them. However, the name "Bebbertown" was in use as late as 1759.

Township Administration Building

The Skippack Township Administration Building is located at 4089 Heckler Road between Bridge Road (Rt. 113) and the Skippack Elementary School. The facility is located on the northeast section of Palmer Park and includes paved walking trails into the park complex. The facility is based upon traditional architecture to complement the character of the community. The lower level contains two community meeting rooms, one with kitchen facilities that are available for community groups.

SKIPPACK HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Skippack Historical Society is celebrating its 50th year of existence, originating from a group of local citizens who opposed the original design and extent of the Evansburg Dam Project. The volunteer group continues to research and preserve the rich history of the Skippack Valley.



The society is again planning for “**Washington’s Encampment in Skippack**” to be held on Saturday, September 30 - Sunday October 1, 2017. This living history event commemorates when George Washington and 10,000 Continental Army Troops were camped at Skippack in 1777, before and after the Battle of Germantown. Re-enactors from the 1st New Jersey Regiment of the Continental Army will set up camp on Friday evening and will be marching, drilling and firing muskets during the weekend. On Sunday the P.A. Rifle Regiment will join them with George Washington and additional generals and soldiers, representing what camp life was like.

There will be colonial crafters, a cooper, basket weaving, butter making, colonial cooking, tin punch activity, quilting, a dulcimer concert, Betsy Ross, a one-room colonial schoolhouse presentation, tours of the historic farmstead and much more. There will be a food wagon for your convenience. Our location is on Skippack Pike opposite the post office.

Consider joining the Skippack Historical Society and help us to preserve our community’s past. Call to schedule a tour of our IndenHofen Farmstead (circa 1713) and learn more about Skippackville and our local history.

Thunder and lightning storms happen all the time. Know what to do to keep you and your family safe when storms strike!

Safety Tips

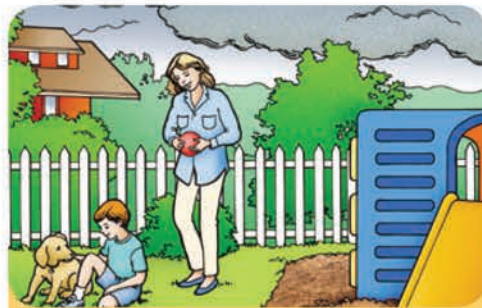
Outdoor Safety

- » **If you can hear** thunder, you are within striking distance of lightning. Look for shelter inside a home, large building, or a hard-topped vehicle right away.
- » **Do not go under** trees for shelter. There is no place outside that is safe during a thunderstorm.
- » **Wait at least 30 minutes** after hearing the last clap of thunder before leaving your shelter.
- » **Stay away** from windows and doors. Stay off porches.
- » **There is no safe place outside.** Places with only a roof on sports fields, golf courses, and picnic areas are not safe during a lightning storm. Small sheds should not be used.
- » **If a person is struck** by lightning, call **9-1-1**. Get medical help right away.

Indoor Safety

Turn off computers. Stay off corded phones, computers, and other things that put you in direct contact with electricity or plumbing. You **can use** a cell or cordless phone.

Do not wash your hands, bathe, shower, do laundry, or wash dishes.

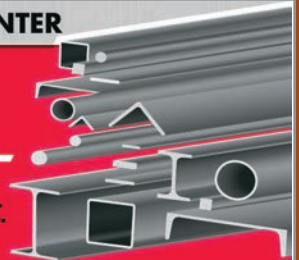
