Natural Resources

Woodlands, streams, and open space are major assets

Concerns

- Flooding issues
- Overdevelopment
- Light pollution from prison
- Water quality
- Lawn chemicals

Potential Solutions

- More open space focus on preservation and acquisition
- Replanting trees due to ash borer issues focus on native species and partnering with local growers

Natural Resources

Strengths

Watershed Conservancy

Open Space Fund

Weaknesses

- Unprotected historic resources, many have gone away (historic but may not be historically significant)
- Not having environmental committee or active shade tree group

Opportunities

- Working with Watershed Conservancy
- Form Environmental Advisory Board
- Active pursuit of open space
- Work with Consortium for Skippack Creek
- Communicate with CPVRPC on flooding issues
- Greenways study
- Outreach and education
- Working with neighbors (adjacent municipalities on these issues)

Threats

- Flooding and stormwater runoff
- Development of potential preservable open space
- Redevelopment of historic properties
- Chemical runoff from illegal dumping, increased development and traffic, chemicals for snow removal, and spill accidents
- Climate issues such as brush fires
- Non-native plants
- Future development of prison property

Historic Resources

Strengths	Long term residents and people who have grown up in the community Artifacts and personal narratives Engaging events Plenty of historically relevant properties
Weaknesses	No strong collaboration between township, schools, and community partners Lack of protection in zoning
Opportunities	Many properties that could be adapted for reuse Interest groups in area to partner with (other historical societies and foundations)
Threats	Continued flooding in area Overdevelopment Migration of people who are stakeholders in historic preservation leaving the area

People seem generally very satisfied with Skippack's parks and recreation opportunities Trail connections are a major asset People love Lenape and Palmer Parks Ensure park amenities meet the needs of all ages and abilities Potential improvements • More passive open space Playgrounds need updating Splash pad • Lights on tennis courts • Safer pedestrian connections to and from parks

Strengths

Breadth of recreation opportunities

Active use recreation activities, natural areas

Blessed by availability of parks, trails, and connectivity that extends far outside of the community

Weaknesses

2 parks are underutilized and less accessible by walking

Lack of pickleball courts

Opportunities

Pickleball court location – Hallman's Grove

Better outreach/marketing for underutilized parks such as Hallman's Grove

Lenape Park – more sheltered areas for picnics in natural setting

Threats

Lenape pavilion – some flooding issues

Graffiti problems many years ago that were resolved partly from a trail being put in.

 - Business turnover and storeowners leaving
 - Parking

 - How to enhance the commercial areas of Skippack
 - Increase lighting along 73

Concerns about high density housing, overcrowding, and losing the current small-town character of the township

How to balance maintaining the character of the community, and ensuring there is enough housing to support the business community and serve the needs of residents

Focus on maintaining the quality of existing housing through architectural standards

Strengths

• Pride of ownership and well-maintained properties

Weaknesses

• Diversity of cost

Opportunities

- Create architectural design guidelines
- Develop unoccupied spaces with housing consistent with existing character

Threats

• Development of housing inconsistent with community character

Transportation & Mobility

Transportation and Mobility

Concerns

- Congestion backups along Skippack Pike at rush hours
- Street paving needed in residential areas
- Speeding in the downtown
- Narrow sidewalks
- Ensure circulation is not overly impacted by development

Potential Improvements

- Increase pedestrian safety in the downtown, especially by adding safer, more high visibility crossings
- Do a speed study
- Traffic calming along 73

- Library building is old and in need of updating


Opportunities


- Fire and EMS long range plan to move to paid services and volunteer attraction



Which of the following environmental issues are you most concerned about in Skippack Township? Please select your top 3 choices.








How often do you visit parks and recreation locations in Skippack Township?





Which of the following initiatives should Skippack prioritize regarding parks and recreation? Please select your top 3 choices.



Q11 How often do you visit businesses in downtown Skippack?









Which of the following economic development initiatives should Skippack focus on? Please select your top 3 choices.






Which of the following housing initiatives should Skippack prioritize? Please select your top 3 choices.



How satisfied are you with the following transportation infrastructure in Skippack?




Which of the following transportation and mobility initiatives should Skippack prioritize? Please select your top 3 choices.
